

What is Manna House?

Manna House is a ministry of Figtree Anglican Church (since 2002) that brings food and friendship to our community, and where there is an opportunity each week for those we serve to hear the word of God. Manna House operates on Thursday from 5pm - 6:30pm on Thursdays during school term at Figtree Anglican Church. The volunteer team typically serve from 4:40pm to 7pm, many on a fortnightly basis.
